

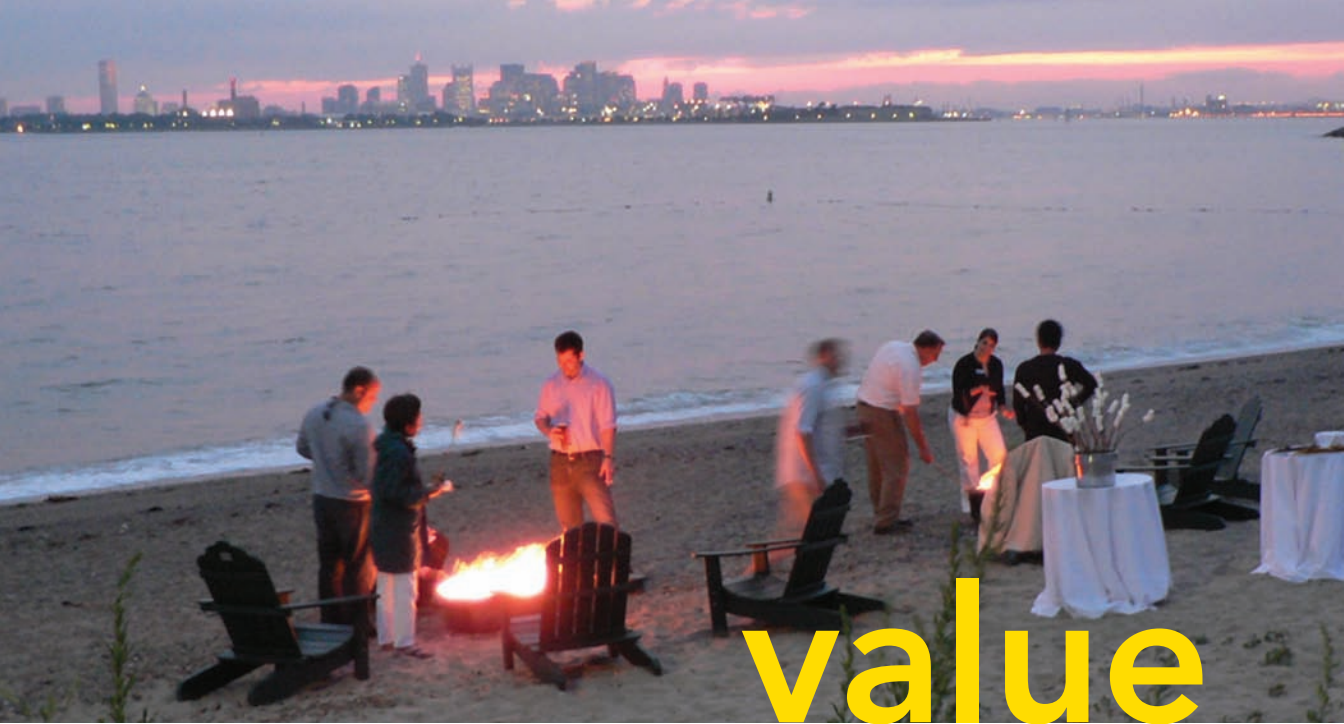

Boston Harbor Islands national park area includes 34 islands, 1,600 acres of land, and 35 miles of undeveloped shoreline, all within 10 miles of downtown Boston. 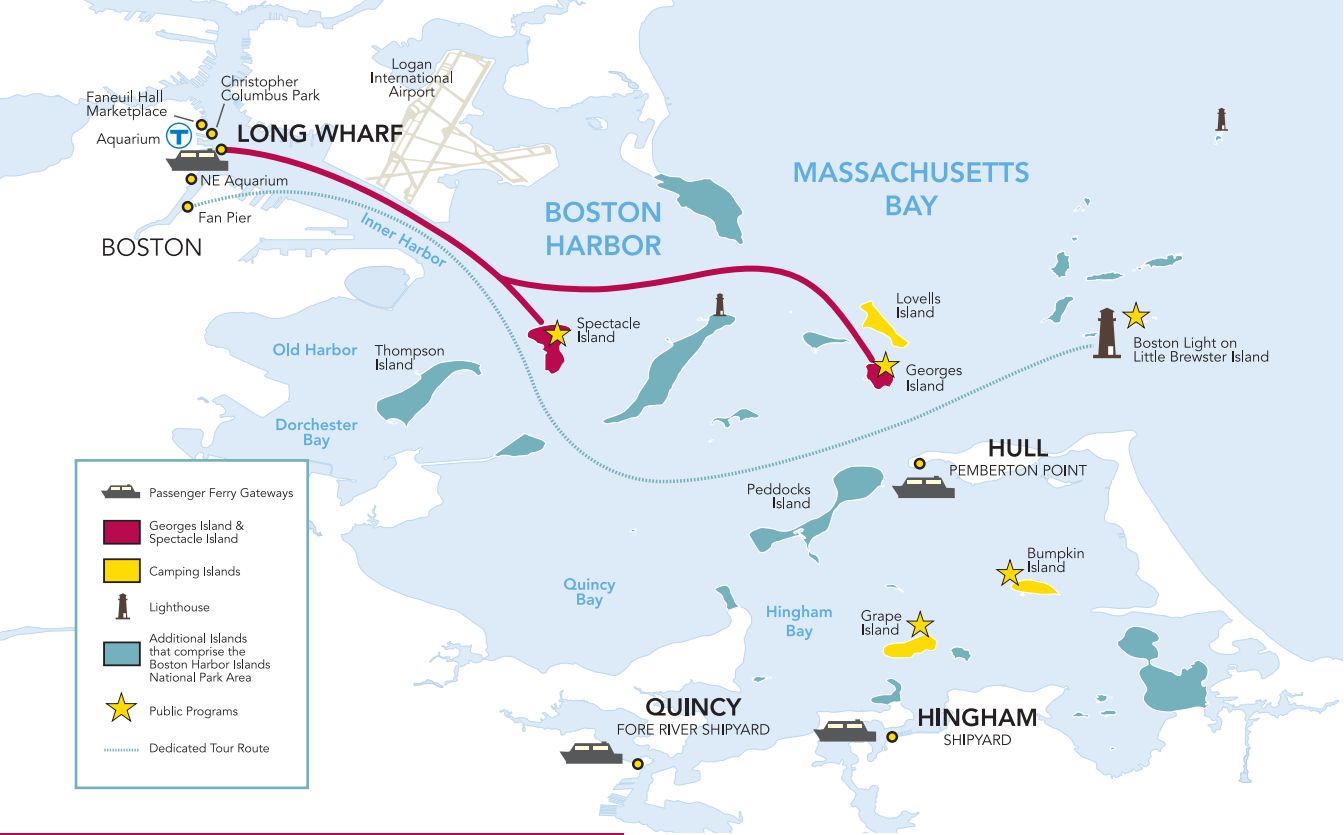
